EMT licensure is often the first step in a rewarding healthcare or emergency services career.

EMT CLASS OVERVIEW

The course is a combination of lecture and practical skills. Students will learn proper response to medical emergencies, patient treatment in the field and proper transportation of sick or injured patients.

This is a State of Michigan Department of Health and Human Services approved EMT program. Upon successful completion, students are eligible to take the National Registry EMT Certification exam. Course will consist of 221 hours of classroom instruction and 64 hours of field clinicals.

Field clinicals will be conducted at Medstar Ambulance as well as Henry Ford Macomb and McLaren Macomb.

PAY

The median annual wage for emergency medical technicians (EMT's) and paramedics was \$31,980 in May 2015.

JOB OUTLOOK

Employment of EMT's and paramedics is projected to grow 24% from 2014 to 2024.*
